And certainly, the ANSWER KEY of this banquet of practice activities is provided in Book 2.

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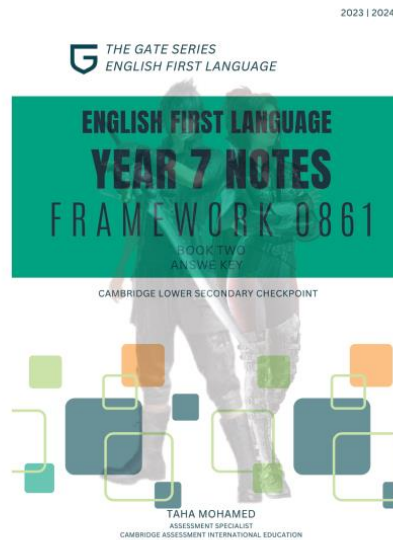
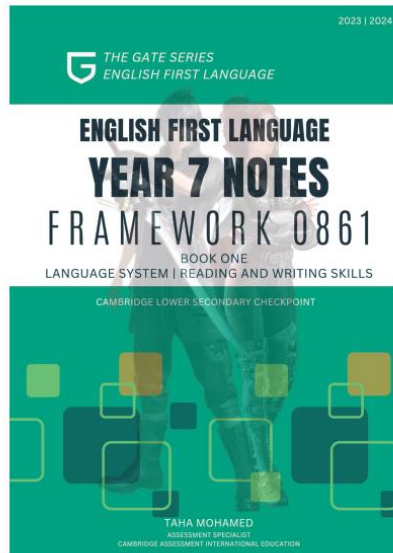
